



Spirits Industry Congratulates NSW Police on Cracking Down on Drunks Behaving Badly

Police Minister Michael Gallagher and the NSW Police Force should be congratulated for re-enforcing the laws around drunken behaviour as part of Operation Unite.

“People who abuse alcohol, get drunk and go on to be violent and behave in anti-social ways, need to know that there will be consequences”, said Stephen Riden, Manager Research and Information for the Distilled Spirits Industry Council of Australia (DSICA) today.

DSICA is the peak industry body for the spirits industry in Australia and has for some time been advocating for a return to traditional enforcement of the laws which can be used to clamp down on inappropriate behaviour and violence linked to the misuse of alcohol.
